Sponsorship
DUSA clubs can seek out sponsors from the community and create a DUSA sponsorship agreement.

Faculties and Schools
DUSA clubs have received funds in the past from faculties and schools keep in mind they often have their own application process.

Membership and Sales
Most clubs charge a membership fee as per their constitution. Clubs can also choose to make money from selling merchandise such as t-shirts and jumpers.
